NAWIC GREATER WASHINGTON, DC CHAPTER **2026 SCHOLARSHIP INFORMATION AND APPLICATION**

ELIGIBILITY

Scholarships are open to women in the following categories:

1. Full-time, part-time or incoming first-year associate or bachelor's degree students majoring in construction management, engineering, architecture, project management, or another construction-related degree program. Students may be enrolled or waiting for acceptance to one of these programs.
2. Students currently indentured or enrolled in (or have been accepted into) a US Department of Labor Office of Apprenticeship registered construction related training/apprenticeship program, technical school in a construction trade, or equivalent.

REQUIREMENTS

1. Applicant is responsible for submitting their signed and completed application form no later than **Sunday, June 14, 2026 at 5 PM EST**, to the Greater Washington DC Chapter of National Association of Women in Construction.
2. Winners must be available to accept the scholarship in person, at an event on August 5, 2026 in Washington, DC at **Spin 1332 F St NW, Washington, DC 20004. Event begins at 4:30pm.**

SUBMITTAL OF APPLICATION

1. All applications are due ***no later than Sunday, June 14, 2026 at 5 PM EST***, to the Greater Washington DC Chapter of National Association of Women in Construction. Applications shall be submitted by email with the subject line "**Washington DC NAWIC Scholarship Application.**"
